Unfortunately, as with all books, mistakes can make their way to the printers.


Sometimes it's due to not enough proofreading and occasionally it's because of too many proof-readers!

All we as a publisher can do is ask that if you find a mistake in one of our publications, please let us know via our website.


Below you will find a list of all known mistakes in our publications. These will be removed in their next printing cycle:

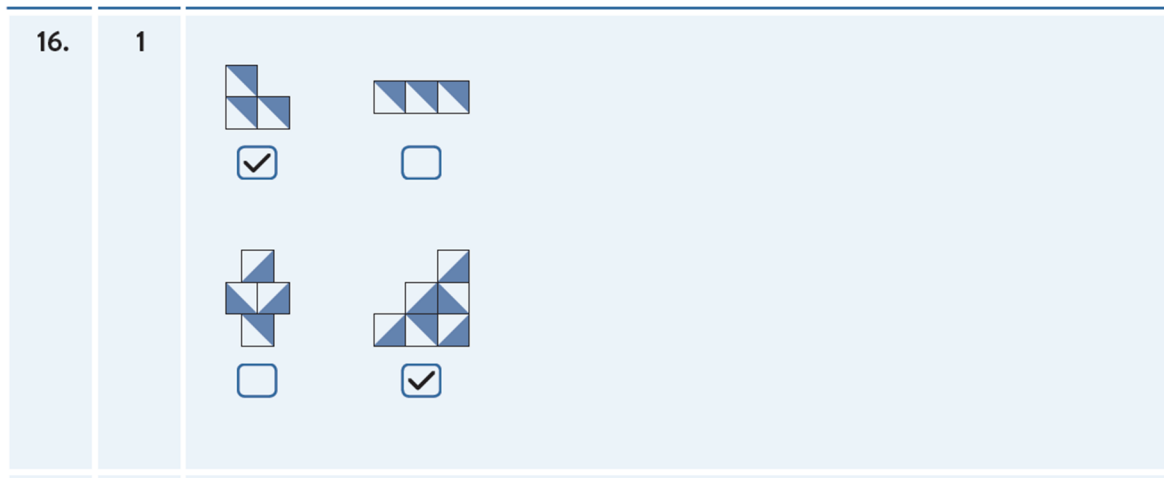
- Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) Set A - Page 10 – Question 17
 - The answer section reads [**p** =] when it should be blank as the question already quotes p and is asking for a calculation.
- Answer & Mark Schemes Booklet – one printing process (in late 2023) mistakenly printed the wrong images on pages 17, 18, 19.
 - Page 17, Question 4. This is the correct image:

4.	Up to 2		<p>Award 2 marks if all four shapes have been correctly matched. Incorrect answer? Award 1 mark if two shapes have been correctly matched.</p> <p>Do not award a mark for any shape that's been matched to more than one fraction.</p>
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- Page 18, Question 14. This is the correct image:

14.	1		<p>The four hexagons must be a similar shape to the example below to have a perimeter of 28cm.</p>

- Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) Set C - Page 5 – Question 8
 - The selection of numbers is incorrect.
 - Instead of '150' it should read '50'.
- Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) Set B – Page 13 – Question 18
 - The numbers that children are expected to place into the diagram are incorrect in the question booklet.
 - The numbers should read:
4 12 24 18 36 40 48
- Answers & Mark Schemes - Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) Set B – Page 13 – Question 29.
 - The answer is incorrect and should instead read as below:
 - 351,552
- Answers & Mark Schemes - Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning) Set C – Page 23 – Question 8.
 - The answer is incorrect and should instead read as below:
 - 50, 25
- Answers & Mark Schemes - SPaG Paper 1 (Questions) Set B – Page 64 – Question 41.
 - The answers have been incorrectly reversed and should be the opposite way around as below:
